



## Holiday Lighting for Downtown

The [Light Up Blue Ridge Committee](#), the [City of Blue Ridge](#) and the [Blue Ridge Business Association](#) have teamed up to **LIGHT UP** downtown Blue Ridge this holiday season.

With each store/building owner's approval we will be stringing white Christmas lights across the tops of all buildings on East and West Main from Church to Mountain, Roberts Way from the Depot to Mountain, Depot from East Main to West First. We would start the installing process right after Safe Zone and start taking them down right after the first of the year. Light Up Blue Ridge will take the responsibility of storing the lights until next holiday season.

The necessary white lights for your building will be provided, the city will do the installing across the top of your store using the appropriate hooks for your type of building so to cause no damage to the building and take the lights down right after the first of the year.

Your responsibility would be to provide an "outdoor" quality extension cord long enough to reach from your roof top to the closest electrical outlet in your store and to have the extension cord available at your front counter no later than November 1st. When the city crew is ready to work on your building they will come into your store to pick up your extension cord.

We ask you to plug in your extension cord around dusk each evening and leave the lights on all night unplugging it when you come to work the next morning. From past experience we anticipate the increase in your electric bill will be nominal.

We are so excited that our entire downtown area will have that old fashion holiday feel that we all remember from our childhood.

We approve the installation of Christmas light along our stores roofline and hold harmless the City of Blue Ridge, Light Up Blue Ridge and the Blue Ridge Business Association.
