



Parade Guidelines and Instructions

No Santas on your float please!

1. Fill out the reverse side of this card with information about your organization, business or group. The MC will use this information when announcing your float. Keep this card with you and a parade monitor will collect it when you approach the start of the parade route.
2. Participants are not allowed to throw, handout or project by any means, any candy or items from the parade float. However, “Walkers” (i.e. participants on foot) are allowed to hand out candy/items before and during the parade. Candy may only be passed from hand-to-hand. Under no circumstances is candy to be thrown or tossed anywhere along the parade route.
3. Please do not exit the parade route prior to the end of the parade.
4. Once your entry has started along the parade route, no one may board your float.
5. Any entry with live animals is responsible for immediately curbing/cleaning up after their animals.
6. Alcoholic beverages and other controlled substances are forbidden.
